This memory book contains data that was collected as part of this year's 30th high school reunion. The committee wanted to get this book out fairly quickly after the reunion, which happened on September 8-9, but, well, you know about "things happening." We did have a draft of the book available for the reunion and we mailed out a copy to the electronic mail group on October 5<sup>th</sup>. Since that mail out, we have been able to collect some "missing Hammondites" and some others have found us. Therefore, this version is a little bit beefier than was originally thought, a hidden benefit to taking so much time on this book.

We have updated the website to reflect information collected since the reunion.

Here are a few facts for you on the 30<sup>th</sup> reunion.

- We had 374 classmates in our database. We could confirm that five classmates had passed away (descriptions are available on the second page of the memory book), leaving 369 classmates listed as active;
- Of these 369 listed classmates, we had current addresses for 169 class of 70'ers, 7 teachers, 3 class of '71, and 3 folks who were at Hammond up to their Senior year;
- We had 114 classmates who have supplied us their e-mail addresses (which are also up on the website - [www.marshallhall.org/hammond70/emaillist.htm](http://www.marshallhall.org/hammond70/emaillist.htm));
- There were 154 classmates for whom we have no information, an additional 27 classmates were found for the 20<sup>th</sup> reunion, but have since dropped out of sight. Any information you can supply on these missing classmates would be greatly appreciated (they are listed at the end of this book and on the website);
- over 75 of your classmates provided biographies for the memory book

On Friday September 8, 2000, we met at Hammond for tours of the school and pictures. There was a casual get-together later at the Capitol City Brewery in Shirlington. We had 41 classmates and their SO's (significant others) and friends in attendance.

Two Madison students found young Ryan in about two feet of water near the shore of Newman Lake on the Madison campus about 4:30 p.m. Saturday, 21 hours after he was last seen by friends in his dormitory Friday night around 7:30. His death was said by a medical examiner to be an apparent accident.... A graduate of Hammond High School in Alexandria, he was an outstanding student and was editor of the school newspaper, a representative to the Junior Class Board and a letterman on the soccer team. He was also a squadron leader in the Civil Air Patrol and was active in "The Second Front," a military affairs club at Hammond. At Madison College he planned to major in English and he wanted to be a high school teacher, college officials said.

Thirty years on I am pleased to say that most days I find myself still working on lessons first undertaken while at Hammond--academic and personal. My life has unfolded on its own timeline. The "dawning of the 70s" left little more than dim memories. The purchase of a 1972 Firebird on a part-time Woodies' paycheck brought paternal wrath and a painful lesson in timing and economics.

Somehow, by 1978, I had my BA (Economics, American University) and then went on to grad school (Georgetown).

Following a few years as an economist at the Bureau of Labor Statistics, I headed for professional uncertainty along Park

Avenue and Wall Street (Citibank, Drexel Burnham Lambert, and Chemical Bank occupy the CV, punctuated by some creative self- or unemployment). By some twisted fate, my studies and career have been tied to the subjects I hated most at Hammond--maths. Even now, I'm only functional, but that's a lot better than any math teacher ever had reason to expect.

In 1996, I joined Deloitte & Touche and moved with the firm to France in 1998. With Paris now planned as home for the foreseeable future, I am reminded daily of the absence of linguistic skills in my Mrs. Lansburgh's Spanish classes. My daily dialogues can still make those in the know grin, grimace or laugh. Taking on a new language at this stage of life is little different than being a five-year old and wondering what the adults are saying. Fortunately, most of my work is in English or in tongues no one would ever expect me to know.

It was at Hammond that I largely formed a view of the world I live and work in today. It was large enough for us to hide in (an adolescent prerequisite), and small enough to feel like a true community. Recently, a colleague shared his surprise that I would travel back to the States to attend a high-school reunion. He remarked that he barely remembered anyone from those years. Seeing the names and (recently) many of the faces from our Class, I think we must have made something worthwhile out of the forgettable.

No matter where I am, people want to know where I'm from. (Perhaps, it is not always just a polite question.) Alexandria remains "home", and with a life of travel, that awareness becomes ever more valuable. Without a wife or children, it's hard to describe the personal side of the 30-year story without feeling like you're leaving questions unanswered on the proverbial "test". In short, a core group of long-time friends helps to connect the dispersed dots in my life. Much to share, but little to tell. Maybe next time.
